We look forward to coming together as a community for SARRC's 3rd Annual YES Day for Autism! In leading up to YES Day for Autism, SARRC will launch a fundraising campaign. SARRC's 2nd Annual YES Day in 2022 welcomed more than 130 teams, 36 event sponsors, 31 nonprofit partners, and an estimated 3,500 attendees who participated in the in-person event. Participants, nonprofit partners, and sponsors helped SARRC exceed the event fundraising goal and raised nearly \$430,000.

### WHY SUPPORT AUTISM?

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) impacts 1 in 44 children in the U.S. occurring in all racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic groups. Roughly 80% of individuals with ASD are younger than 22, and in the next 10 to 15 years as many as 500,000 will age into adulthood nationwide. Moving forward, it will be critical to ensure that individuals have access to a lifetime of services, resources, and support to maximize independence, increase self-sufficiency, and achieve success long-term.
