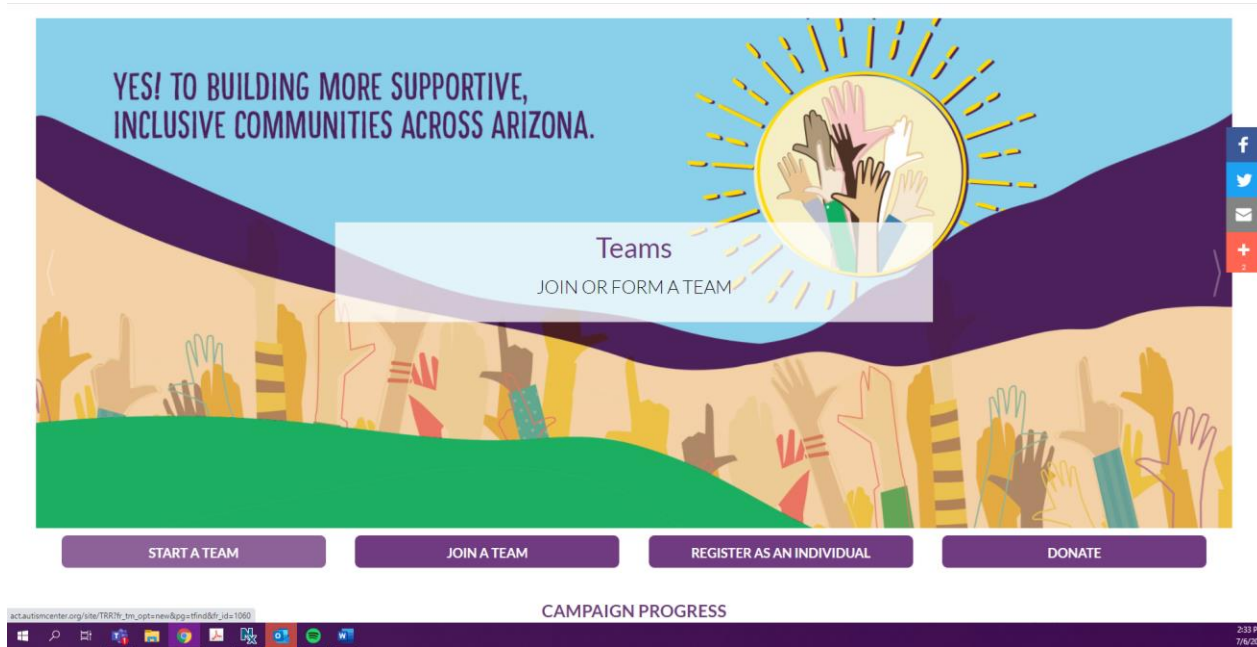


## HOW TO REGISTER FOR YES DAY FOR AUTISM

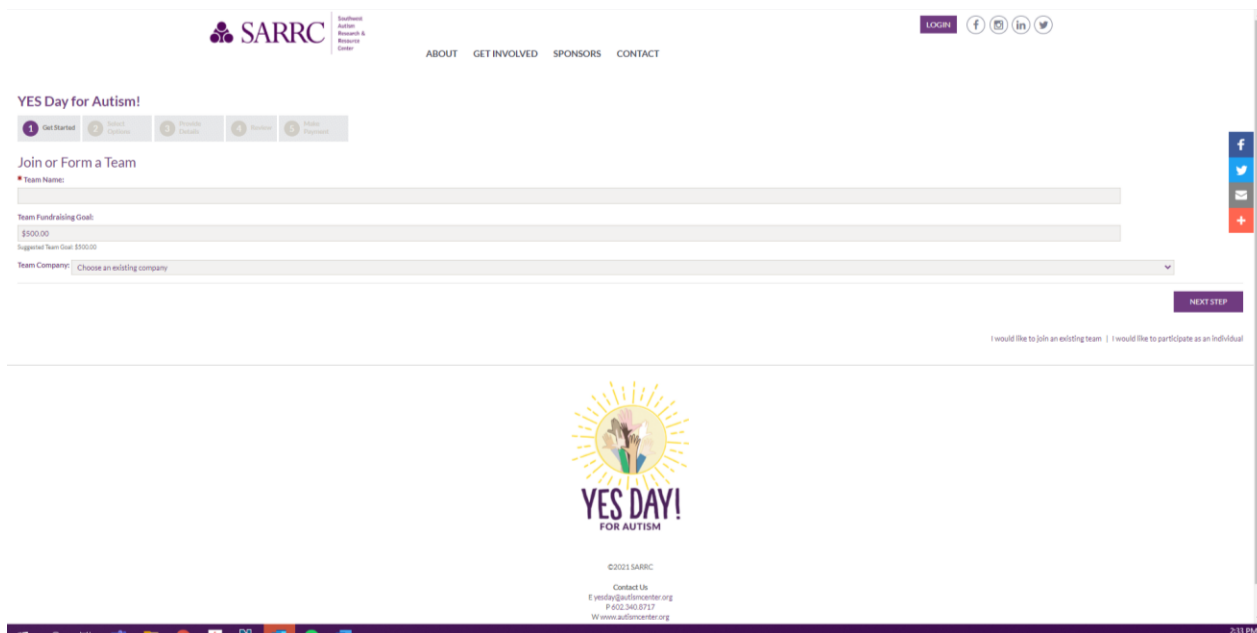
### Click on:

- The correct registration option for you.
  - Start a Team, Join a Team or Register as an individual.



### Step One: Get Started

- If you chose Join a Team
  - Select your team name
  - Enter your team fundraising goal
- If you chose Join a Team or Register as an Individual you will be prompted to the Select Options step.



## Step Two: Select Options

- Set your personal goal (this is different than team goal).
- We suggest \$100 to earn the commemorative YES Day for Autism shirt.
- Make an additional gift. This is where you can make a personal donation to your goal.

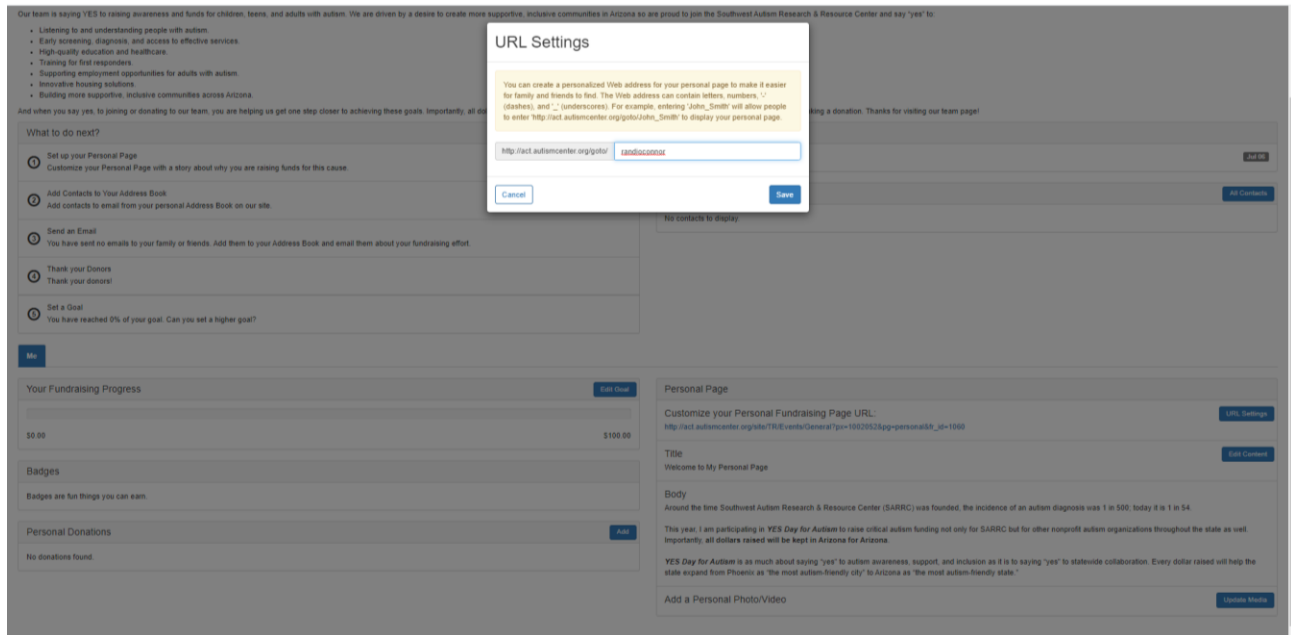

    - Adding a personal photo/video.

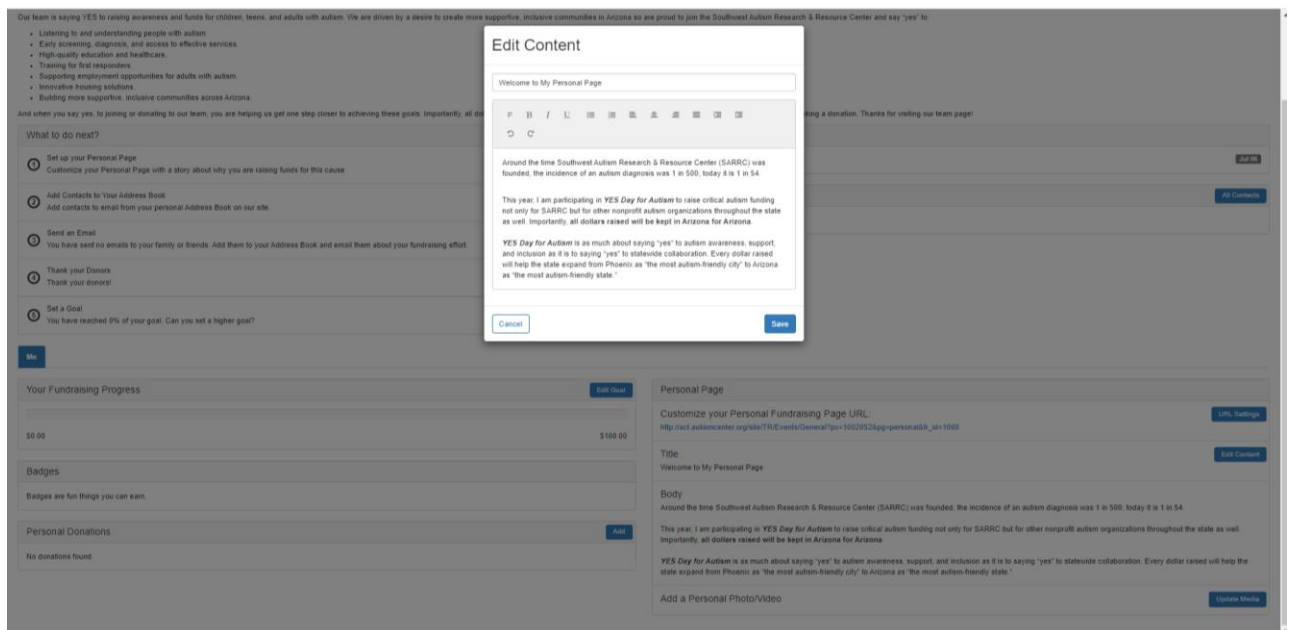
## How to customize your URL Setting

- Click on: URL Settings
- Select an easier URL for example: first and last name (randioconnor)



## How to Edit Page Content

- Click on: Edit Content
- Update your page title and content to reflect your why. We suggest including why you are participating and who you are participating for.



## How to Add a Personal Photo/Video

- Click on: Update media
- Choose a file from your computer that you feel represents your reason for participating.
