

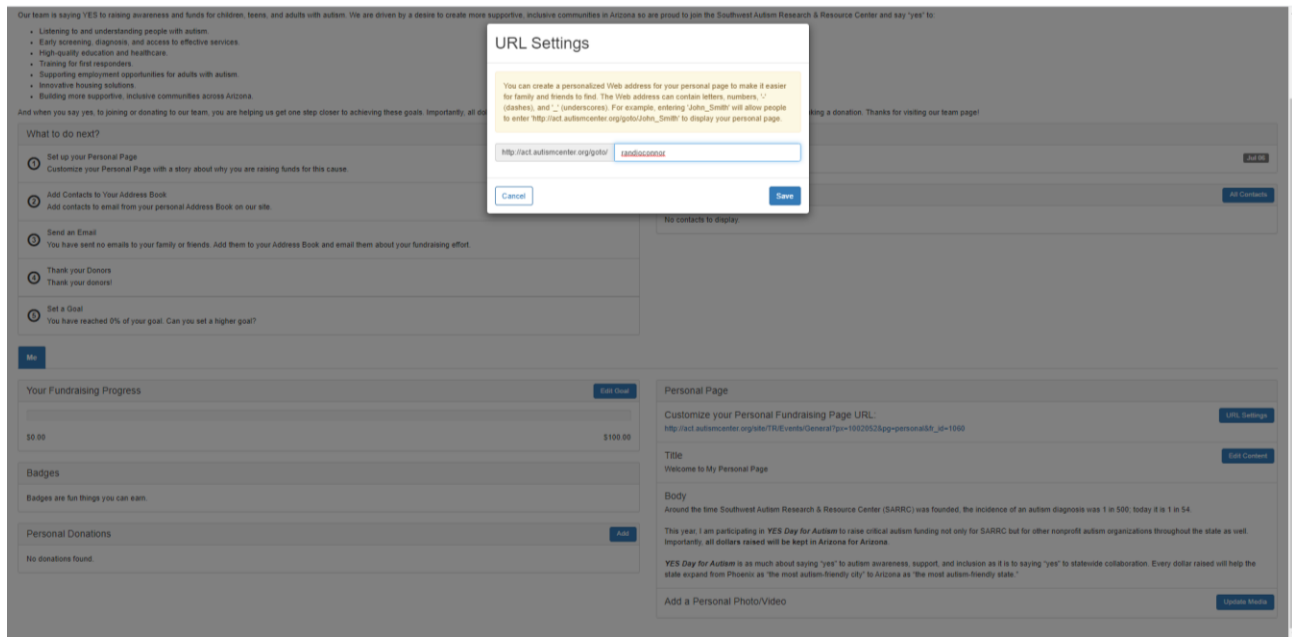


Make it Personal!

 - Adding a personal photo/video.

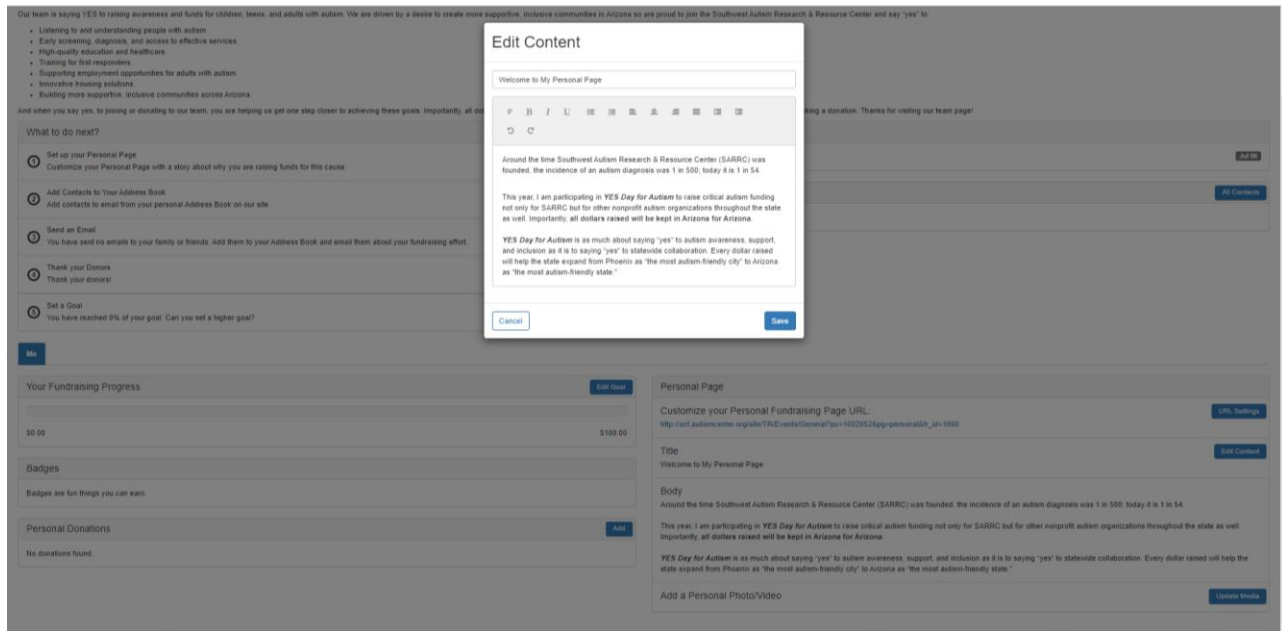
How to customize your URL Setting

- Select an easier URL for example: first and last name (randioconnor)



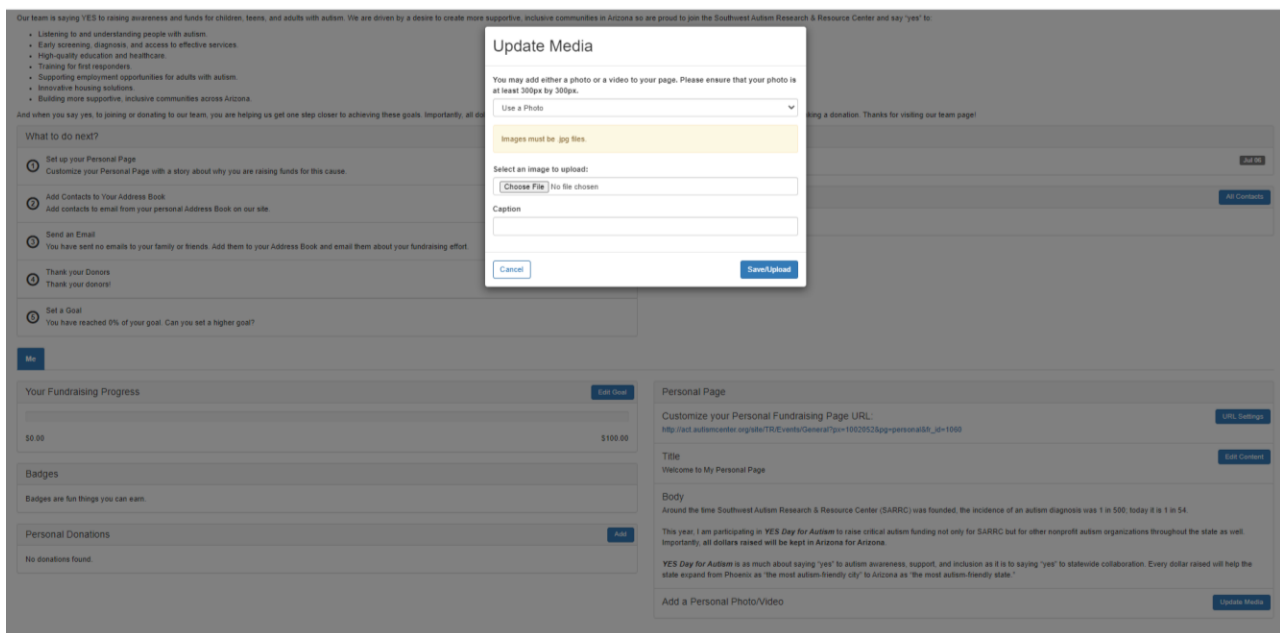
How to Edit Page Content
